Project Management Certificate

Our Project Management Certificate is now being offered for credit! This is only for the cohort taking their first course in January 2012 and does not apply to those already enrolled in the certificate. To register for the program, you will need to fill out a non-degree application and mail your check in to the address listed on the form, or you can register by calling 215-881-7400 and we are happy to take your registration and payment information over the phone. Books are not included in the price. There is also an additional technology fee of \$82 per semester.

The Project Management Certificate program is a structured series of courses designed to prepare students for careers in the planning and business fields. A Penn State certificate is awarded upon successful completion of the four required courses.

Required Courses: Project Initiation and Planning, Project Scheduling and Integration, Project Costing and Control, Project Risk and Change Management. You may also take MS Project Overview as an additional, though not required, course.
