**Academic Advising Notes:**

1. PHIL 10 is a recommended GH course.
2. MATH 21 and STAT 200 are recommended GQ courses; MATH 21 is a prerequisite for MKTG 301.
3. ECON 2 or 4 and PSYCH 100 are recommended GS courses; either of them is a prerequisite for MKTG 301.
4. ENGL 202 D is recommended for Corporate Communication majors.

5. B A 304, MGMT 100, MGMT 301, or 3 credits of psychology, sociology, or cultural anthropology are prerequisite for MGMT 321.
6. MGMT 321 is a prerequisite for MGMT 424.
7. MKTG 221 or BA 303 is a prerequisite for MKTG 310.
8. PSYCH 100 is prerequisite for PSYCH 221 and PSYCH 423. PSYCH 321 is a prerequisite for PSYCH 423.
9. US or IL courses may double count in Gen. Ed. or the major but not as an Other Cultures course.
